

# CLARENCE MACKAY FIREMAN.

He's a Regular Volunteer at Roslyn  
Now and Must Run with Engine.

ROSLYN, L. I., Oct. 14.—Clarence H. Mackay has become a regular volunteer fireman here, and henceforth when an alarm of fire is rung he will have to run with the engine or pay a fine of \$1, unless he is out of town at the time of the fire. He was elected a member of the Rescue Hook and Ladder Company at its last meeting a day or two ago.

For some time Mr. Mackay has been an honorary member of the organization as a mark of appreciation on the part of the fire company in return for the \$5,000 engine he presented to the company a year or two ago. It is understood that Mr. Mackay's promotion to active membership was made at his own request, and it is expected that he will fulfill all the duties of his new place.
